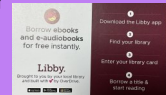

Year 2

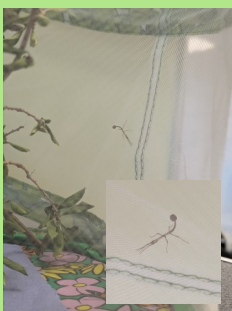


Year 2 have some new additions to class this week!
