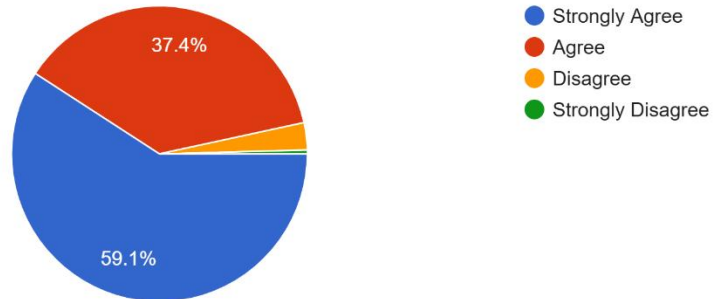

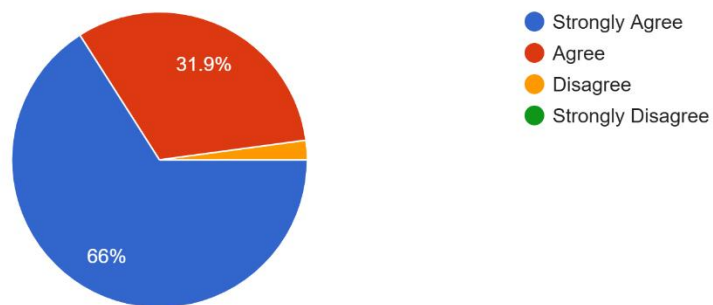
My child is happy at school

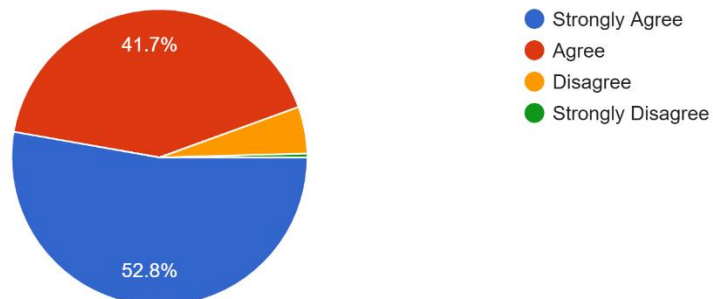

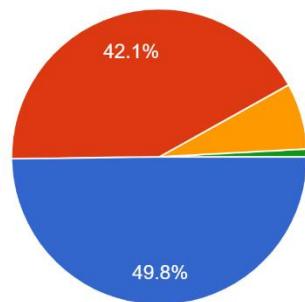

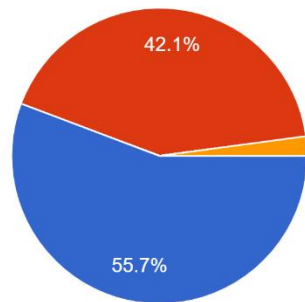

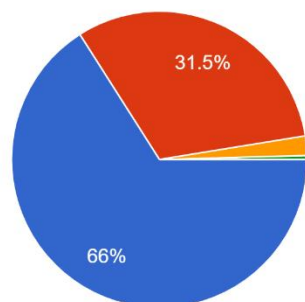

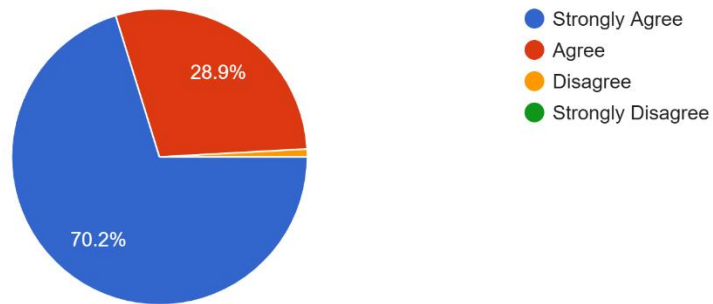

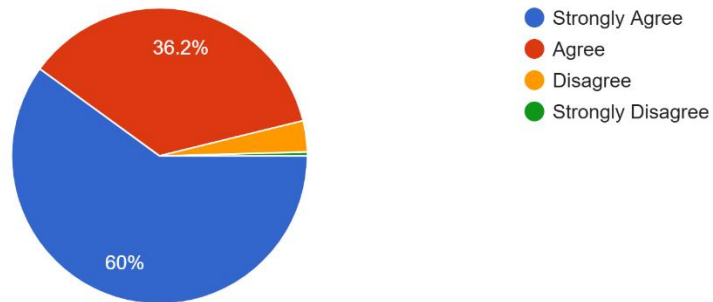

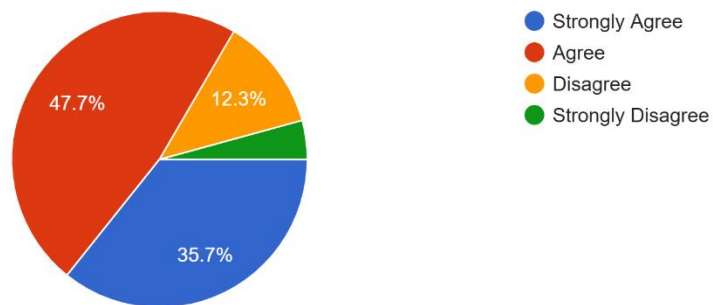
Staff expect my child to work hard and do his/her best

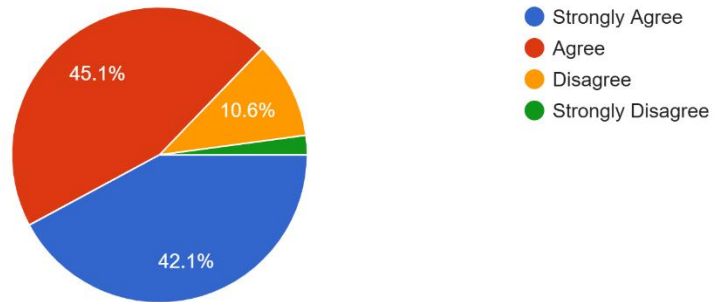

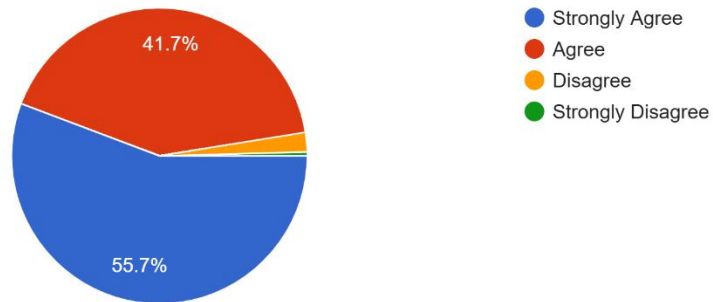

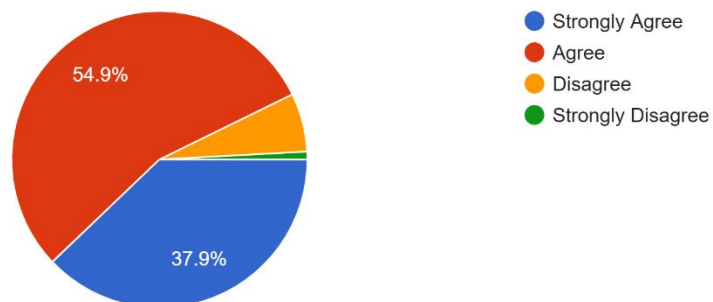

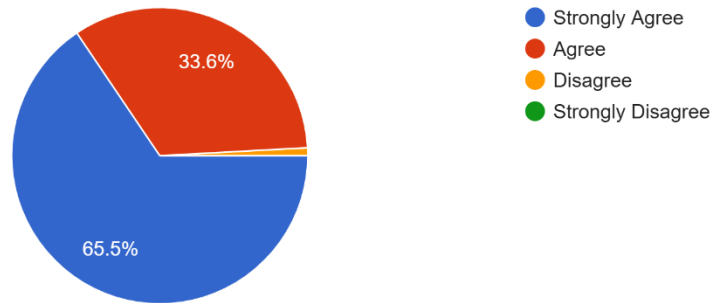


Pupils at the school behave well

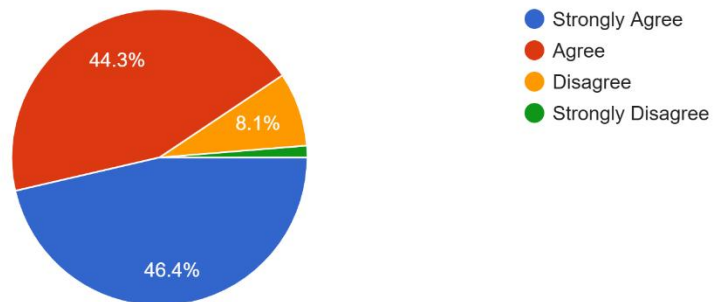

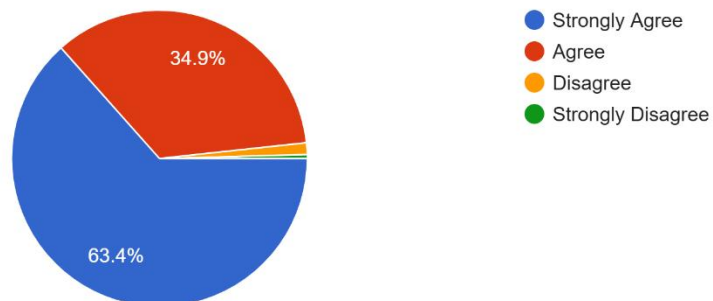
