- **Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5 please enter via the main office on Meyler Avenue.**
- **If you have a child in KS1 and KS2, school staff will be available to guide you through school to their classrooms.**

Parents collecting their child from our After School Club, please note that you will collect your child from the door to the left of the main entrance (Year 5 doors next to the office) on this day.
