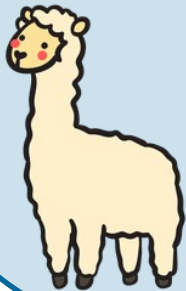
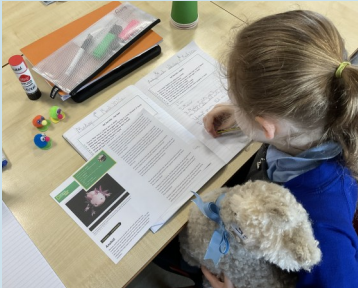
Layton Llamas – Our Attendance Champions!
