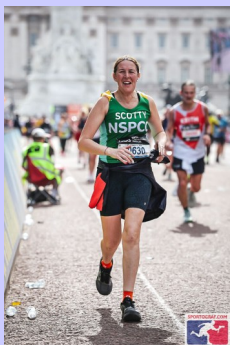
While the experience was certainly challenging, the training journey has been immensely rewarding. It reinforced an important lesson: resilience really does carry you through.

This is a reminder that school is closed on Monday 4th May 2026 for the Bank Holiday.

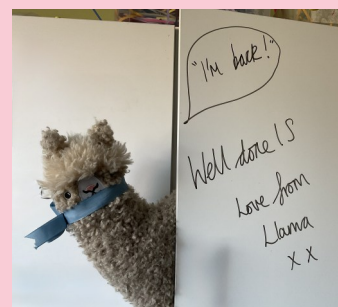
School will be open as normal from Tuesday 5th May 2026 at 8:40am.
