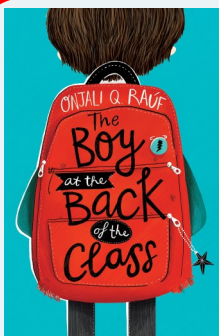
Should the weather cause any disruption, we will inform you on the day, giving as much notice as possible via Parent App.
