Every child who achieves 96% attendance across the school year, 96% attendance for this half-term or both will get an ice-cream treat at the end of term!

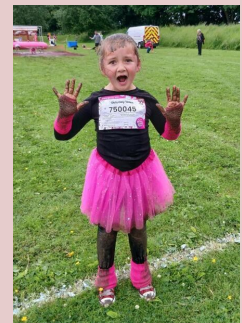
